1. Online Classes commencement:

Primary and Secondary:

Online classes for classes IX – XII commenced on 01 June 20. For I to V Digital classes, VI – VIII online classes commenced on 08 June 20 with inclusion of co-scholastic subjects as well in the curriculum.
