I. SPECIAL ASSEMBLIES

1. International Youth day:

International Youth Day (IYD) is an awareness day designated by the United Nations that takes place on August 12. The purpose of the day is to draw attention to a given set of cultural and legal issues surrounding youth. The first IYD was observed on 12 August 2000.

A special assembly was performed on 11th January 2024 to celebrate the event. The theme and the importance of the day was presented by the students of class 7th. The children danced wonderfully to the tunes of few songs – The students have also taken Oath and presented various quotes using placards.
